**Stained Glass: Introduction to the Copper Foil Method**

Using the copper foil method, you will assemble a 10"x10" panel experimenting with a variety of glass, negative space & miscellaneous solder-able materials. This is one of my favorite projects - be prepared to think outside the box! We will be discussing glass cutting, grinding, copper foil, soldering, and patina application.

**Fused Glass: Painting with Light**

"Painting with Light" is a decorative method in fusing using glass powders, frits and stringers – the result is a generally softer effect than fusing sheet glass to sheet glass. In the first session, you will make a variety of sample tiles using various techniques. In the second session, you will use what you've learned to create a 4"x4" square plate.

**Fused Glass: Introduction to Jewelry**

Using a variety of colorful fusible glass (including dichroic), you will be designing 2 glass pendants and a pin. In the first session, we will cover glass cutting and the basics of fusing, and you will design and prep your pieces for firing in the kiln. In the second session, you will finish your incredibly gorgeous (!) jewelry by making simple cords for your pendants and applying a pin back to the pin.
